



STATE UPDATES MASK REQUIREMENT FOR INDOOR & OUTDOOR DINING

The state of Illinois has issues new requirements for wearing a mask/face covering in restaurants and bars to increase safety for restaurant workers and patrons. The new changes require patrons to wear a face covering over their mouth and nose during an interaction with their wait staff or other employees at restaurant and bars.

EXAMPLES OF WHEN A MASK/FACE COVERING ARE REQUIRED INCLUDE WHEN A SERVER/RESTAURANT EMPLOYEE:

- Takes your order
- Deliver food or beverage
- Clear your table, or
- Collects payment or provides any other service at your table

The new requirements apply to both indoor and outdoor restaurants/bars and other facilities with food service areas, such as indoor recreational facilities and entertainment venues.
